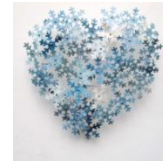

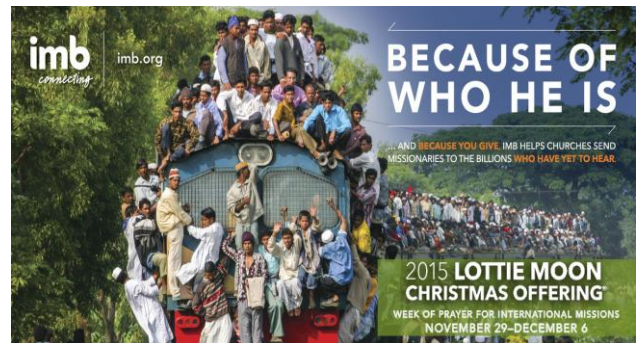

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



It is now December, and the countdown to Christmas has begun. The calendar for the month of December is filled to overflowing with shopping trips, parties, Christmas programs, and family get-togethers. I would like to suggest one more thing to put on your calendar...daily. Read Luke 2:1-20 every day in December, because THIS is Christmas. The real story of Christmas too often gets lost in all the preparations, decorations, and consternations. Reading that passage every day will only take a few minutes of your time, but it will help you keep everything in the proper perspective. There are 3 points I would like for you to ponder.

1. The Good News was declared first to the shepherds, not the rulers, or the rich.
2. When the shepherds heard the Good News, they went to see for themselves.
3. After they had seen it, they returned glorifying and praising God.

We are Christ's present day shepherds. When you hear, or read the Good News, what will you do? Will you instantly forget it and return to the hustle and bustle of the season, or does the proclamation of the angels make you yearn for more? Do you file it away in your memory bank, or do you share it with those around you by glorifying and praising God?

Christmas is the season for giving and receiving gifts. God gave us Jesus; will you share Him with others? Merry Christmas and God bless you all.
