HOLY SPIRIT-DIRECTED FASTING

It is surprising. **Jesus** fasted (Matthew 4:1-11). **Moses** fasted (Exodus 34:28). **Esther** and **Uncle Mordecai** fasted (Esther 4:16). **David** fasted (II Sam 12:16). **Daniel** fasted (9:3). Anna fasted (Luke 2:36-37). **Cornelius** (Acts 10:30), **John the Baptist** (Luke 5:33) and **Paul**, too (II Cor 11:27).



What is more, groups of people fasted. **The inhabitants of Jabesh Gilead** fasted (I Chr 10:11-12). **All the Jews in Susa** fasted (Esther 4:16). **The citizens of Nineveh** fasted (Jonah 3:7-10). **The Antioch church** fasted (Acts 13:2-3). Jesus assumed we would, too. "When you fast..." (Matt 6:16)

You know that fasting is the forsaking of an item or a practice for the purpose of seeking God. Food, certain foods, entertainment, sex or whatever the Holy Spirit leads you to sacrifice. Some give up one meal, another will surrender two or three meals. One has given up TV on Wednesday. Another avoids the telephone. That is between you and God.

You must be deeply committed to God to practice fasting. It causes humility. It expresses utter dependence upon God. Every hunger pang reminds you to call out to God, to lift up your soul to Him, to seek His Face.

The carnal Christian will not fast. He will avoid it - laugh at it. Fasting is not for the half-committed. Fasting creates great humility before God.

Fasting is without ostentation. It is part of "the iceberg spiritual life" -9/10ths secret and 1/10th exposed. It is part of your hidden walk with God.

There is no question of whether God is willing to move in His people. Rather it is an issue of our willingness to surrender in full obedience to him. Genuine, heart-felt, Holy Spirit-directed fasting results in God's seismic spiritual activity among His people.

The church has set Wednesday as our day of united fasting. (Any other day will work just as well for you, of course.) Participate only if God leads you to do it. Practice it only as He directs. And, please, if you have medical problems, be wise. Guard your health. Christian, guard your heart.
