LOSTOLOGY

Ever studied the doctrine of “lostology”? It is a very important doctrine. Sometimes it is called “the fall of man” or “total depravity”. I like to call it “lostology”. Doesn’t it have a ring of profundity! (jus’ jokin’ ‘bout that)

It means that “all have sinned & come short of the glory of God”. A man doesn’t have to do anything to become lost. He is “condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God’s one & only Son”, Jesus. (John 3:18)

What can we do about these lost people? Here we go:

1. LOVE THEM. We usually call them “prospects”. That’s a business term. We describe them as “unbelievers”. That’s O.K., of course. But some Christians renamed them “the people Jesus misses most”. Another church refers to them as “the precious ones”. Jesus has an affinity for the lost, the loose, the lowest – as we once were. They really matter to God. So they matter to us.
2. PRAY FOR THEM. Do you have a prayer list of at least five “precious ones”? Bombard heaven regularly for their salvation.
3. INVITE THEM. Your friends will come to church if you invite them...& invite them...and courteously invite them again.
4. REPORT THEM. Yes, report them to the pastor. Like this: “Preacher, my very good lost friend is here today. I’m going to be praying that the Holy Spirit will use your sermon to bring him to Christ.” Then stand back & watch that pastor preach his heart out!
5. PRAY LIKE CRAZY. Pray throughout the sermon. Three men prayed strongly every time Bud Lentz attended church. It’s no wonder that Bud was saved & radically changed.

There is a terrific new pastor coming...
