ESPIRIT DE CORP

You have long understood “**esprit de corp**”. (eh-spre-de-kor) It is “a common spirit of comradeship, enthusiasm and devotion to a cause among members of a group.” As you well know, those three French words mean “SPIRIT OF GROUP”.

You **see** it in school pride. Example: You **feel** it the build up to a crucial football game...in the team warm-up, the cheer leaders, the pep squad, the student body, the supporting community in the stands! That “spirit” is tangible in the marching band, the national anthem, at every yard gained, every point scored, the helmet-slapping victory of the players, the sudden dowsing of the coach, the after-game celebration!

You have observe it in the military. At any moment a marine can tell you, “**God, Country, Corp!**” and “**Once a marine, always a marine!**”

And esprit de corp in a church? Essential!

What makes for esprit de corp in a church? Many things. Here are just a few:

Pride in God – What a Mighty God we serve! He is Glorious, Great, Good! What a Savior is Jesus! “I know Whom I have believed....!”



Pride in leaders – The pastor is proud of the deacons, Bible teachers, musicians, members. The people take pride in their pastor, SS leaders, worship leaders. (You recall how his men loved Patton.)

Pride in members – A church comprised of genuine, godly, spiritual, alive, passionate saints. People we admire and emulate!

Pride in self – A person suffering depression is usually most of all disappointed in himself. When his sense of self-worth is restored he soon emerges from depression. The genuine Jesus-loving-serving Christian feels his value to God. (still aware of his lowliness and sinfulness, of course)

Pride of vision – The church has large spiritual and numerical goals. “Have no small goals. They are ineffective,” they say. God’s challenges!
