

WE DO NOT KNOW THAT WE DO NOT KNOW

There are two kinds of Christians: (1) those with a **teachable spirit** and (2) those with an **“unteachable” spirit**.

There is so much we do not know. The problem is that **we do not know that we do not know**. We can foolishly think that we know all we need to know. Some want to learn more. Others have no such hunger.

How much we have yet to learn about God, worshipping Him, loving Him, serving Him!

Read this. An early Baptist preacher, Benjamin Keach, is credited with introducing hymn singing to English Baptist churches. He began with the children because they loved singing. Their parents did not. They were convinced that singing was “foreign to evangelical worship.”

A great controversy arose when Pastor Keach sought to introduce hymn singing to the Horsley Downs church. With Biblical evidence (Matt. 26:30) he got them to agree in 1673 to sing a hymn after the Lord’s Supper. He allowed those who objected to leave before the hymn. Six years later the church agreed to sing a hymn on “public thanksgiving days”.


In another 14 years they agreed singing was appropriate to worship. Imagine! 20 years passed before that church agreed hymns were good, appropriate and worshipful!

However, 22 members left that church to join a non-singing congregation. But, wouldn’t you know it! That church called a pastor who made hymn singing a condition of his accepting their call as pastor!

Oh, for a teachable spirit! We have so much to learn! So far to go!
